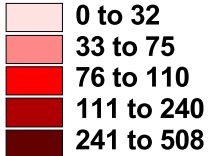

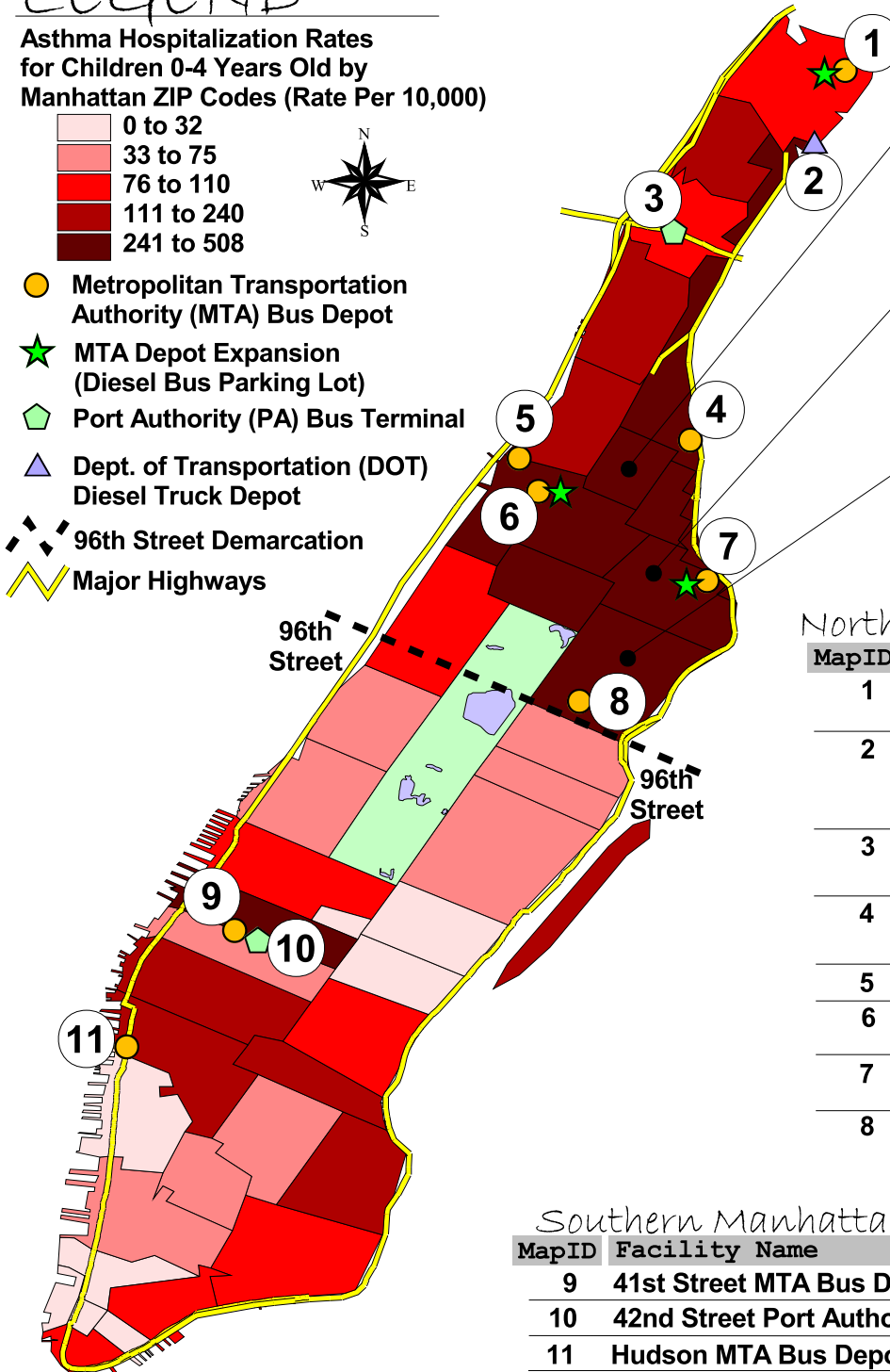
Diesel Fuel Polluting Facilities, MTA Depot Expansions, and
